

Watching On Demand on Vernon Communications

On Demand programming, sometimes referred to as Video on Demand (VOD) is a value added feature new to Vernon Communications' television subscribers.

You can choose from the most recent movies and older favorites, along with episodes from some of your favorite TV shows, special sporting events, play-lists of music videos and even karaoke. Unlike Pay-Per-View, which only allows you to watch the program once at the scheduled time, On Demand programs are available for 24-hour, 48-hour and 72-hour periods so you can start it, stop it, and play it when it's convenient for you.

On Demand allows you to determine what and when you want to watch, and how often during the rental period. You can even pause, rewind or fast forward just like a videotape or DVD. Rental prices are comparable to prices at your local video store, and many programs are free!

On Demand is the ultimate in convenience and entertainment in your home! No more hassles and video rental stores. You rent when it's convenient for you.

Renting & Navigating On Demand:

**To Access On Demand programming*

Press Menu on your remote, highlight "On" or "On Demand" and press RIGHT arrow button to select "LIBRARY". Then press OK

**To Browse Rentals*

On Demand rentals are grouped into categories and sub-categories to make finding what you want very easy.

Step 1: Use the arrow key to scroll down or over and pick a category
Highlight a main category and press OK.

Step 2: Browse the Rentals

When you choose a category; a list of available On Demand rentals for that category are shown on your screen.

Highlighting an On Demand rental title will list information for the Rental on your screen.

If you want to learn more about the rental, highlight the title and press Ok. Select “WATCH” or “BACK”.

Note: At any time during this process, you can press the left arrow button to return to a previous set of categories.

**To Rent an On Demand program*

Follow steps 1-2 for Browse Rentals to find an On Demand rental that you are interested in. Press OK.

Step 1: Highlight “RENT” and press OK.

Step 2: Confirm Your Rental

The confirmation screen appears. Please be sure you have the correct title and you are aware of the price that will be charged to your account.

If you have additional set-top boxes in your residence that you want to be able to watch this On Demand rental, highlight the Share Whole Home check box, select “YES” or “NO” and press OK.

Step 3: Enter your PIN

Highlight the text box next to Enter PIN and use the number pad to enter your PIN. *(Note: Your PIN is 0000 by default.)*

Step 4: Rent!

Highlight “RENT” and press OK to confirm your On Demand rental. (It is very important to note that once you press OK, you will be billed for your On Demand rental).

Your rental will begin playing immediately.

Controlling Rental Playback:

While watching an On Demand rental you can use the Playback control buttons on your remote to pause, rewind, fast forward or stop playback.

*Press Pause to halt playback at the current point.

*Press Rewind or Fast Forward to reverse or advance playback from the current point.

*Press Play to resume watching at normal speed.

*Press Stop to exit playback of the program.

The Slider:

Anytime you press a Playback Control button while watching an On Demand rental, the Slider appears. The box at the top left indicates the playback function in use.

The box at the top right indicates the current playing point of the video.

The bar in the middle gives a visual representation of where you are in the program. The lighter section indicates how much of the program has been played.

Watching an On Demand rental from Your Library:

To watch an On Demand rental you have already rented, press “Menu” on your remote and highlight “ON DEMAND”, then press “RENTALS”. Press OK. You will now see any rentals that are still within the viewing window of your rental period.

Step 1: Pick your Rental

Highlight your On Demand Rental and press OK.

Step 2: Play your Rental

Resume playback from last position or restart from the beginning. Highlight “RESUME”, or “RESTART”, or “EXIT” and press OK.
