## **IRISH CROCKPOT BEEF STEW**

**INGREDIENTS:** 2 lbs. beef chuck

- 1 bay leaf
- 1 large carrot
- 4 garlic cloves
- 2 tsp. fresh thyme
- 1/2 large yellow
- onion
- 2 Yukon Gold potatoes



2 C. beef broth
1/4 C. tomato paste
1 Tbs. Worcestershire sauce
1/2 tsp. black pepper
2 Tbs. all purpose flour
1 tsp. kosher salt
1 Tbs. olive oil

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

Cut beef in small chunks and season with salt and pepper. Sprinkle the flour over the seasoned beef and coat on all sides.

In a large skillet, heat the olive oil over medium heat. Brown the beef in batches on all sides for 3-4 minutes or until slightly browned. The beef does not need to be cooked through. Transfer the browned beef to a plate and set aside.

Add the onions, garlic and carrots to the skillet and cook stirring occasionally for 2-3 minutes or until slightly browned. Add the broth and let it cook for another minute to remove the glaze from the bottom of the skillet.

In the crockpot, add the potatoes, tomato paste, bay leaf, thyme and worcestershire sauce. Add the beef. Mix well to combine everything.

Cook on low for 9 - 10 hours, medium for 7-8 hours or high for 6-7 hours.

**To thicken the stew:** 30 minutes before serving, remove about 1/2 cup of the liquid sauce, mix it with about 2 teaspoons to 1 tablespoon of cornstarch. Pour it back and allow to cook and thicken up. *Remove bay leaf, serve and enjoy.*
