Vernon Communications recognizes the importance of a strong, reliable internet connection. Now more than ever we rely on communication through the internet for education, business, social and personal uses.

The cooperative has had great success in growing its membership over the last 15 years. Over 31% of our membership growth is from outside of our 8 original cooperative serving areas. *"We have had great success in obtaining Broadband Expansion Grants to grow the cooperative, with more planned for the future." states Rod Olson, CEO.* To date, VC Co-op has overbuilt the entire Viroqua-Frontier company, along with the Village of Cashton and rural areas. Construction is in progress and will be completed in early 2023 in the geographical areas of Northern Crawford County, from Rising Sun to Seneca and continuing on from there to the Mississippi River.

We are also very pleased to announce that VC Co-op has been selected for 2 more broadband grants in the townships of Portland, Leon, Sparta, Jefferson, and Wells in Monroe County. This will be finalized at the next Public Service Commission open meeting. The 10 successful Broadband Expansion Grant projects to date total \$22.6 million dollars. These grants, along with other municipal contributions account for 71% (\$16.1 Million) of the total project costs. In short, these grants are enabling us to reach over 3,300 new cooperative members for less than 30% of the deployment cost. This growth, as great as it is, requires organizational and operational changes that the board discussed. "We do not want to lose focus of member service and our long history of staying on the cutting edge of technology", said Garin Mayer, General Manager and future CEO. Brad Gabrielson, Board President states, "We are in a great place to be able to look at growth, enhancements, and the long-term viability of our areat cooperative. All of the fiber construction we have done so far has been at a discount that saves the cooperative money. It's an exciting time for the future of this cooperative."

VC Co-op board of directors and senior management held its Strategic Planning meeting on July 12, 2022. Discussion of several topics at this organizational meeting included past, present, and the future growth of the cooperative, as well as department updates from supervisors.
