- Say you're eligible to register for a government refund or offer a coupon for something free

Greetings to you in the shortest month of the year! I'm sure you've stopped writing 2024 on things by now and have adjusted to 2025.

If you are looking at your billing information, you'll see the notice of the 2025 video rate change. Those rates will go into effect March 1st. I would recommend taking a look at our VernonCom streaming packages if you'd like to enjoy video for a little less per month than the traditional set- top-box packages. Your next question may be, "Why the increase?"



Video services are relatively complex when considering the agreements and the amount of entities involved to deliver the services to your home. There are programmers, affiliates, middle ware, hardware, and software entities all involved. Each level requires a negotiation of their costs. Those negotiated costs end up on your bill. The cooperative is the last entity used to deliver these services. The final rate you see on your bill is a reflection of this. We

utilize larger partnerships to negotiate on our behalf in an effort to minimize the increases. We've also created the streaming platform to eliminate some of the overhead costs, in an effort to provide you the entertainment you'd like, for a little less.

On a much more exciting note, I'm pleased to inform you, we have re-opened the front doors of our office! The road construction has progressed to allow parking in front of the building. I will ask that you remain vigilant when you park on the street as traffic traveling on the new road hasn't seemed to slow down any.

If you're reading local news, you may have come across a lot of chatter concerning Broadband Grants. It would seem that everyone, everywhere are receiving these grants! I will caution a lot of what you're reading are pieces of information explaining grants that are being applied for, but have not yet been awarded. The main theme of these grants is the Federal Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) grant, which I've written about previously. The BEAD grant has not yet progressed to the point of applications or awards. With the changes in leadership in Washington DC, there may be a review of how the BEAD grant ultimately proceeds. Here at the cooperative, we will continue to review buildout opportunities that utilize grants when they make the most sense for us. Some grant programs and their stipulations are simply too burdensome or restrictive to be feasible for the cooperative.

I hope you got a chance to enjoy the "Snowflake Ski Jump", in Westby. The annual ski jump competition is a unique event in the area, and is a fun festivity to enjoy in the winter. February also allows us to begin thinking about Spring. If you're like me, it can't come soon enough!

Tech Tips - KnowB4

Social media offers cybercriminals ample opportunities to social engineer or manipulate people to their nefarious advantage. Many do not consider how much personal information is available online and waiting to be used against you.

Social Media - Not Just for Socializing

Social media platforms are also a breeding ground for fake profile personas waiting to take advantage of you. For instance, LinkedIn has a professional influence unlike other social media sites, often making users less cautious when connecting with strangers. When people willingly make these connections under the assumption of making professional networking contacts, criminals can lure them into divulging personal details and direct them to malicious sites. Social Engineering is a neverending weapon for cyber criminals and social media hands them most of the information they need for successful attacks.

Cybercriminals can use a quick company search on LinkedIn to find several contacts from a company, including information such as their job positions and email addresses. This quick search gives the attacker a new list of targets to familiarize themselves with for better spear-phishing attempts. If an attacker wanted to target you personally, they could easily find your favorite hobbies or activities from one or more of your social media profiles. They could then craft a relevant spear-phishing email or text message spoofed to look as if it is coming from a company or person that you commonly interact with. Always be aware of the information you share with the world, and be cautious of how that information can result in you, or your organization being more susceptible to a compromise.
