Have you ever wondered how phishing attacks get into your inbox? Most email clients, such as Outlook and Gmail, have built-in features



to filter out potential threats. Additionally, it's likely that you have extra security measures to help protect your account. Unfortunately, scammers have found clever ways to bypass this security and creep into your inbox.

Technical Tactics

Most security filters work by looking for specific text patterns, file formats, or links to websites that are known to be suspicious. Scammers often bypass this feature by hosting a malicious file on a legitimate file-sharing service, such as Dropbox or Google Drive. Your email filters will not see the linked file as a threat, because it is hosted on a trusted website.

Remember: Never trust a link within an email that you were not expecting, even if it is to a familiar website.

Social Engineers

Bad guys can completely avoid security filters, by sending phishing emails that don't include links or attachments. Instead, they use a technique called social engineering. Social engineering is when a scammer poses as someone else and tricks you into sharing sensitive information. Typically, the phishing email will appear to be from someone important. Then, the scammers try to use this disguise to trick you into replying with sensitive information, sending a confidential attachment, or even wiring money to them.

Remember: Stop and think before you click. Were you expecting this email? Is this an unusual request? Is there another way that this person can, or should, securely gather this information?

A Human Touch

Technology will never catch 100% of threats because the attackers are human. That's why becoming a human firewall is so important.

Remember: Stay on the lookout for suspicious emails. Nothing can catch a bad guy better than a good guy!

La Farge 4th of July Parade




The community of La Farge puts on a wonderful 4th of July celebration and the parade is well attended by people from miles around. VernonCom employees were there to help commemorate the occasion.

Business Spotlight



Viroqua Hills Golf Course is a semi-private golf course and a hidden gem in the state of Wisconsin. The course was established in 1934 as a private 9 hole golf course, known as the Viroqua Country Club. In 1996, it expanded to 18 holes. Not only

is it known for its beauty in the region, but also its challenging nature. The course has received many awards over the years. The most recent award was given by Golfpass in 2024, who listed Viroqua Hills in the top 50 in the U.S.. It has also been listed in Golf Digest as a top course to see. These ratings are based on green fees, complexity of the course, maintenance and beauty. Scott Mason,



General Manager of the course, credits Derek Volden, Superintendent and his team for keeping the course in pristine condition. There is a total of 30 employees and 7 Board members that keep the course running to its high standards. Countless hours go into keeping the course in tip top condition – that means being on the greens by 4:30 AM, or earlier, if needed. Mowing, fertilizing, weeding, and staying on top of the elements in a given year are challenging. Mother Nature is unpredictible, but the employees do what needs to be done to keep the course standards high. Ongoing maintenance, updating, and building is what keeps the beauty of the course exemplary.

Currently, Viroqua Hills has approximately 300 members with over 90 student members. They have 34 tournaments per year with "The Viroqua Open" being the largest. This year is the 57th Annual tournament, which brings in 200 golfers from all over the nation. Many of them come back each year from states such as, Texas, Louisiana, Florida, Colorado, Arizona and Iowa. Another favorite is the "Bill Michaels" tournament. Bill Michaels is a well known sports radio host who for the last 3 years has hosted a golf tournament at Viroqua Hills. His sponsorship benefits the "Big Unit Foundation", which supports Veterans, First Responders and their families. Since he started the tournament at

Viroqua Hills he has supported some non-profits in our area as well.

Not only is Viroqua Hills an attraction for golf enthusiasts, but there is also a bar and restaurant that offers sandwiches, appetizers, burgers, wraps and pizza.
