SEEKING NOMINATIONS

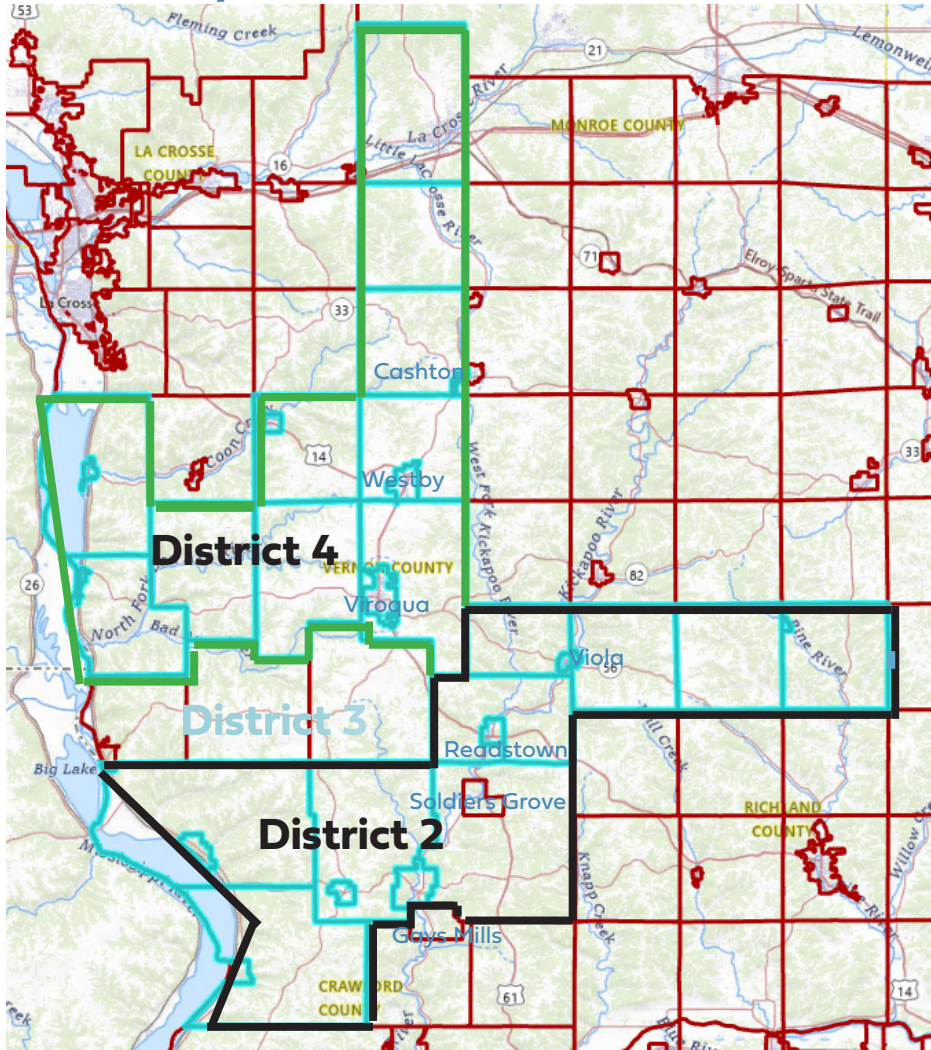

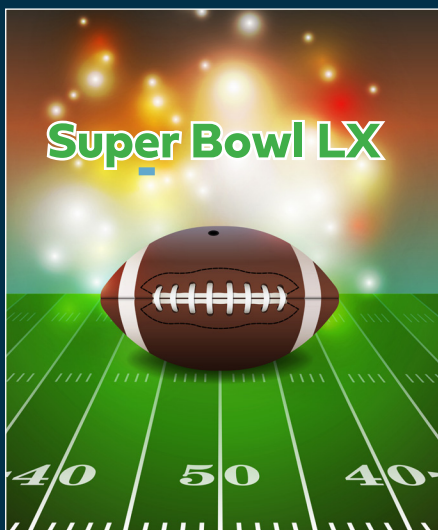
District Map



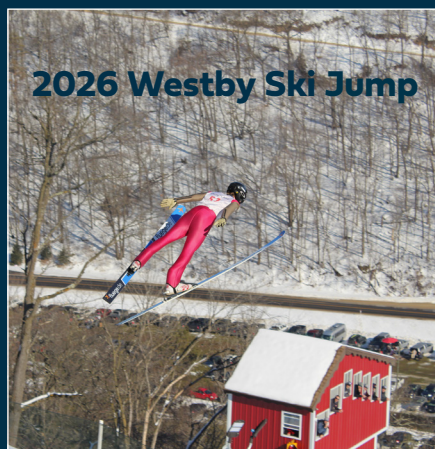
Please note: The cities of Westby and Viroqua are NOT included in District 4, and the villages of Gays Mills and Soldiers Grove are NOT included in District 2.

IRS and Tax Scams - KnowB4

Every year, cybercriminals take advantage of taxpayers like you who are filing taxes or patiently waiting for their tax return. During each tax season, the IRS notices increased phishing attempts to steal your money or tax data, so you must be highly alert.

How It Happens: Tax Scams and Malicious Activity

Cybercriminals have several tax-related tricks up their sleeves when it comes to stealing your money and sensitive information. Here are a few common examples of tax scams:

- Scammers send emails posing as tax service organizations by impersonating, or spoofing, actual tax service emails and using stolen logos. If you respond to the email with your personal data or tax information, they can pocket your hard-earned money.
- Like the scam above, cybercriminals send look-alike emails containing hyperlinks that lead to malicious websites or PDF attachments that can download malware or viruses to your computer.
- Tax scams aren't limited to emails! Be on the lookout for scammers calling, posing as IRS representatives, and claiming you owe money that must be paid immediately. These callers typically threaten you with arrests, deportations, or suspension of business or driver's licenses if you don't pay them.

These are only a few examples, so be aware that these scam artists are constantly coming up with new ways to fool you.

How Do I Stay Safe?

Always remember the following during tax season and all year long:

- You will always receive a bill in the mail before any phone call from the IRS regarding unpaid taxes.
- A request for your credit or debit card numbers over the phone is a red flag for a scam. Legitimate IRS agents will not ask for payment this way.
- The IRS does not use high-pressure tactics, such as threatening immediate arrest or involving local law enforcement for non-payment.
- Taxpayers always have the right to question or appeal an amount owed before the IRS demands any payment.
- Official IRS correspondence about personal tax matters, such as bills or refunds, will never be initiated through email, text messages, or social media.
- You should always avoid sending sensitive information like passwords, credit card numbers, or your Social Security number via email, as it is not secure and can be easily intercepted.

Business Spotlight - Milk & Honey



At the age of 10, Raegan Davy knew that someday she would open a restaurant. At the age of 14, she became interested in the art of making coffee. Her experience as a barista and baker ignited a passion for the food industry. After high school, she traveled to Florida, and for six months she worked as an intern in Culinary. While working closely with a head chef, she discovered the artistry of plating and the rhythm of a professional kitchen, learning firsthand that true craftsmanship is built on hard work. She also observed the preparation and flavor of sauces, and the chemistry of combining it with certain foods.

Last July, Raegan's dream became reality when she opened Milk and Honey Espresso Bar in Westby. Her profound faith in God has led her to fulfilling her dream. She knew at a very young age her restaurant would be called Milk & Honey, which comes from the bible verse Deuteronomy 26:9. (He brought us to this place and gave us this land, a land flowing with milk and honey). Her passion for community is what makes her smile when she sees the connection of friendships come together in her restaurant over a cup of coffee.

Espresso is a different method of brewing coffee, which uses finely ground beans, hot water, and high pressure to create a concentrated shot of rich crema. She uses Bella Goose Coffee and has formed a lasting relationship with the people behind the brand. The most popular coffees are the signature coffees: Honeycomb, Lavender Air, and Dalgona.

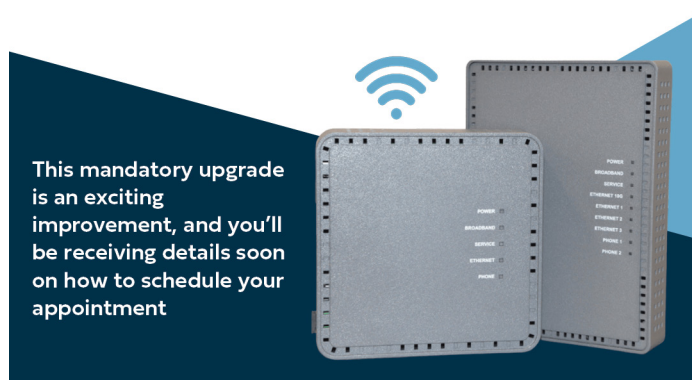
Customers of Milk and Honey notice the flavor of sauces that she incorporates into her food menu. The restaurant offers a savory menu for breakfast and lunch served all day. The hours of business are 6 AM - 3 PM Monday - Thursday, and on Fridays, they are open until 9 PM, serving appetizers, tappas, soup and mocktails from 5-9 PM. During this time, they have events such as bingo, euchre, music and more. On Saturday's, they are open from 7 AM - 3 PM. Her customers utilize WiFi from VernonCom over a cup of coffee in a beautifully remodeled atmosphere of relaxation and comfort. As weather permits,

customers can also enjoy outside seating.
